## Instructions for filling out the Late Cal Grant GPA Verification Form

Use this form if you could not submit an on-time verification. Complete all sections.

#### SECTION A: TO BE FILLED OUT BY STUDENT (Please print clearly using blue or black ink only)

- 1. Month/year of high school graduation: Enter the month and year you graduated, or plan to graduate from high school. Enter the month as two digits (for example: January should appear as "01"; November should appear as "11"). Enter the year in a four-digit format (for example: 2021 should appear as "2021").
- 2. Your CSAC ID is a unique identifier used by CSAC to verify your identity.
- 3. This is used to identify if you will be transferring from a CCC to a Bachelor Degree Granting Institution.
- 4. Your name: Print your last name, first name, and middle initial as it appears on a government issues identification document.
- 5. Your birth date: Enter your birth date. For example, June 25, 2001 would be entered as 06-25-2001.
- 6. Telephone number: Enter your area code and telephone number.

    - · You participated in a home-schooling program or attended an unaccredited high school.
    - You attended a high school or college outside of the USA and are unable to have those grades converted to a 4.00 scale.
    - Your school did not grade in a manner that can be readily converted to a 4.00 scale.
  - Students who have been out of school for five years or more have the option to submit test scores or submit their GPA.
    - If submitting test scores, you must provide a reason for not providing the scores by the filing deadline. Grade reports, transcripts, and other proficiency certificates WILL NOT NE ACCEPTED.
