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MINUTES

1. Meeting Call to Order

Stan Miller called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

2. Introductions

7. Discussion Items

- A. JMCS Government Education Day
 - R.J. Guess stated that there will be two components of a government education day within JMCS: structured lessons at each school site and a day where students can visit lawmakers at the capital. Discussion included spreading student visits to the capital out over several days, who students should meet, what time of year is best to schedule the visit to the capital, and how many students should attend. Michael Corbett stated that February or March would be the best months to visit the capital and that students should visit decision-makers (committee leadership, chairs, governor, etc.). Gil Botello stated that students who visit the capital should see themselves as ambassadors for JMCS. R.J. Guess will check dates for scheduling the government education day. Stan Miller suggested introducing it to teachers at the September in-service.

B. JMCS Branding

A report detailing the representation of JMCS at school site graduations was distributed. R.J. Guess said that there was a good use of the JMCS logo and recognition of JMCS at the various graduation ceremonies. Directors were much more involved in planning the graduations and JMCS paid for more graduation costs than in the past which gave JMCS more power to promote itself at the ceremonies. R.J. stated that he will draft a policy that covers the amount of money for graduation expenses JMCS will pay for, how the JMCS logo must be included in the graduation program, and how the event must be called a JMCS graduation. Discussion included the importance of giving families an opportunity to celebrate their graduates and updating the JMCS tag line of "more than four walls and a whiteboard". This will be a standing item on the agenda.

C. Reformatting the JMCS Foundation

R.J. Guess stated that reformatting and reconsidering the JMCS Foundation is one of his goals as CEO. He would like to have a foundation board meeting before the August board meeting on August 14, 2019, at 9 a.m.

D. JMCS Admin Staff Salary Discussion (Attachment #5, Page 19)

R.J. Guess said the board requested to see this report at last months meeting. All employer costs of the classified administrative staff are included in the report. Discussion included PERS and STRS costs.

E. CEO's Report

R.J. Guess reported on AB1505 and gave a summary of where the bill stands in the legislature. Discussion included the potential impact to JMCS should the bill pass.
