**Public Notice** 

Intent to Require CTE Courses to Fulfill High School Graduation Requirements

In accordance with Education Code Section 51225.3(a)(E)(ii), the John Muir Charter Schools Governing Board hereby provides notice of its intent to revise the school's graduation requirements to require all students to complete a Career Technical Education (CTE) course in place of the current option to complete a visual or performing arts (VAPA) or world language course.

This notice is being provided to inform **parents**, **students**, **teachers**, **and the public** of the following:

- Intent: The JMCS Governing Board is considering a revision to graduation requirements
  that would make a CTE course the required method for fulfilling the one-year high
  school graduation requirement currently satisfied by visual/performing arts or world
  language. Under this proposal, CTE would become the only option for fulfilling this
  requirement.
- Impact on College Eligibility: Many CTE courses do not meet the "a–g" subject requirements for admission to the University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) systems. Students planning to apply to UC or CSU campuses would need to complete additional coursework in visual/performing arts or world language to meet college eligibility requirements.
- Clarification of Requirements: The graduation requirements established by John Muir Charter Schools are distinct from the college admission eligibility requirements of the UC and CSU systems. Completion of JMCS graduation requirements does not automatically qualify a student for admission to UC or CSU institutions.
